

Holy Week Services This Week – Every evening at 7:00pm

Tenebrae: Wednesday, March 27 - 7:00pm Service of Shadows

An ancient service of prayer, and meditation with music. (About 30-45 minutes)

Maundy Thursday: Thursday, March 28 - 7:00pm Eucharist

On the last night Jesus spent with his friends, he gave us the ‘commandment’ to love one another. We remember this night by gathering to receive Holy Eucharist and waiting in darkness as the altar is stripped (remembering the hours of Jesus betrayal and arrest). Following the service, the chapel is open for meditation until 9:30pm. Children especially welcome!

Good Friday: Friday, March 29 – 12:00noon Stations of the Cross (Traditional); 4:00pm Intergenerational Interactive Stations of the Cross; 7:00pm Holy Eucharist

On Good Friday, we remember Christ's suffering and death. We receive ‘reserved sacrament’ rather than a new Eucharist meal remembering that this was the day of Jesus crucifixion and death.

Easter Vigil: Saturday, March 30 - 7:00pm, Lighting of the New Fire (Woodward Avenue entrance), and Holy Eucharist

Our community gathers around the altar fire to hear the stories of God's work in our world throughout history and in the present through the great Salvation Stories. We celebrate the first hours of Resurrection with joy. It is a service of deep mystery, beauty, and darkness which is overcome by light. Children especially welcome! Festive reception follows – if you like, bring something to share.

Easter Sunday: Sunday, March 31 - 8:00am, 10:15am Festal Eucharist

Bring bells to ring!

This festival Eucharist proclaims the risen Christ, the fulfillment of hope, the triumph of justice, and the immortality of love. Bring bells to ring! The children in our parish receive flowers, and the flowers that adorn the altar are delivered to our homebound parishioners following the service.
